The Consultation aims to:

- 1 **Examine** the ethical considerations in the Pact for the Future and the Declaration on Future Generations from an interfaith perspective.
- 2 **Recognize** the role of religious communities and interfaith organizations in safeguarding the needs and interests of future generations.
- 3 **Facilitate** engagement between faith-based and interfaith organizations and the UN to deliver on the Pact for the Future and the Declaration on Future Generations.
- 4 **Develop** mechanisms to raise awareness and mobilize religious communities for the fulfilment of the Pact for the Future and the Declaration on Future Generations.
- 5 **Integrate** the perspectives of children and youth of faith in addressing the themes and issues discussed at the Summit of the Future.
- 6 **Involve** interfaith children and youth leaders in intergenerational dialogue to contribute toward a more peaceful, just, and inclusive world.
